ENVIRONMENTALIST OF THE YEAR



Christine arrived on Earth right after the first Earth Day, the perfect time to be inspired to help our planet. She spent her early years gardening and hiking (still hobbies to this day) and playing and camping in the woods of Upstate New York. As an adult, she found herself still trying to

balance her desire to help wildlife, people, and the environment. She earned a Master of Social Work in Medical and Healthcare Settings from UNC Chapel Hill and pursued helping those with chronic illnesses. With research increasingly pointing to the intersection of increased prevalence of many diseases with environmental pollutants, her two seemingly different interests have become very much intertwined.
